

ENHANCE THE IMPACT OF YOUR LEADERSHIP SKILLS

Executive Forum's unique Advanced Leadership Lab provides a hands-on, application-based look at leadership designed specifically to help mid- to senior-level managers *build the skills needed to maximize the positive impact they have on their organizations*. Beginning with an examination of their own leadership styles, managers are encouraged to evaluate their skills in building effective relationships and getting desired results. Participants are then guided in the use of practical leadership tools they can apply to build and foster an environment of trust throughout the organization.

Organized into three weekly sessions to provide opportunities to practice new skills, participants also receive **two one-hour individual telephone coaching sessions** from an experienced executive leadership coach—one before the course begins to calibrate expectations and discuss challenges, and again after the final session to identify a way forward and outline individual actions for continued development. An added feature is the **option to extend executive leadership coaching and add a comprehensive 360° assessment package**. Extended coaching and comprehensive assessment have proven highly successful in further transforming the performance of managers by providing clear objectives and support in achieving leadership goals.
